- Clubs would like a Play HQ refresher session prior to registration for 2023 season
- Junior Rep Players in Club Teams
  - There was a lot of discussion had
  - It was agreed that a sub-committee be formed to look at this more thoroughly for the 2024 winter season
- Borrowing Rules
  - The clubs agreed that the by-laws around borrowing need to be amended.
    - They would like players to be able to play three games in one day
    - A player can be borrowed any number of times

- After seven games a player is considered a member of that team
  - Keep the by-law stating that a borrowed player cannot take the court if an original team member is available.
  - The number of original v borrowed players on court to remain the same
  - For finals series a team can borrow from any team below, even if that team is also in finals
  - Create an equivalency table for junior grades for borrowing, like seniors.
  - Junior Rep players cannot be borrowed.
- Net Set Go
    - Again, clubs were divided on the issue of playing NSG on Friday night or Saturday
      - It was suggested that this needs to be investigated further
    - It was agreed that this is the area to concentrate on regarding growth of the Association.
    - It was also pointed out that some players may spend 3 or 4 years in NSG. Maybe we need to look at an u9's competition division again.
- Senior/Junior Competition
    - Clubs would like to change the by-law about the minimum age for Cadet players
    - Clubs would also like the ability to register junior players in the senior competition
    - Players could be registered in both a senior and junior team
    - It was suggested that maybe we could look at combined age groups on ability rather than age.
    - Rather than Cadets maybe we could have U17's & U19's in line with NNSW.
