Supervision from a parent or guardian is compulsory for the first season of umpiring

Coaching may be provided by a Club Mentor.

Umpires Certificate (UC)

Typically, 1st & 2nd Year
Umpires
Coaching provided by a Club
Mentor

Club Mentor to complete the HDNA UC readiness checklist

Testing sheet completed over half a game (30 mins) by Umpires Committee member or delegate

Once a UC is awarded the umpire automatically becomes a National C Candidate (removing the need to nominate or wait for the following season)

National C Candidate (CC)

National C Candidates receive coaching from Club Mentors and sometimes Umpire Committee

The Umpire mentor completes
HDNA's National C readiness
checklist

Exceptional Umpires may receive their UC and Nat. C in the same season

For increased exposure to coaching and to enhance development umpires can attend:

- Junior Rep Carnivals
- Junior Rep Trials

It is expected that a National C
Candidate completes 1 carnival as a
volunteer to be eligible for C Badge
Testing

National C Testing

To achieve a National C the umpire must:

Have a current exam mark of 70% or higher

Be registered in PlayHQ

Have completed their foundation course

A National C is awarded over a whole game practical test (1 hour) by 2 testers -One National B and One Naitonal B or C
