



HDNA JUNIOR REPRESENTATIVE PARENTAL OBLIGATIONS AGREEMENT 2026

- I have read and agree to abide by the NSW Netball Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct which can be found on the HDNA website under Policies, Netball NSW Policies, Code of Behaviour Policy.
- I understand that all players in the HDNA Representative Program are required to play with an HDNA affiliated club in the winter competition on Saturdays.
- I understand that if my daughter is selected in any team/squad she must attend all training sessions, carnivals and games as organised by the coach or Association, unless ill or injured. My daughter will not attend training or games if she is unwell, has respiratory symptoms or a fever. To return to play after injury, a signed medical certificate is required.
- I understand that for players returning from injury in the three weeks prior to the State Titles, medical clearance is required from HDNA's preferred provider, Thornleigh Performance Physiotherapy, or any other specialist sports physiotherapist. The player will need to be able to train and play at maximum capacity and anticipate that they would be able to successfully complete the three days of competition at a minimum of 40% court time.
- I understand that after 4 weeks of initial training my daughter may be requested to trial in another position if requested by the coach or selection panel. I also understand that once selection has been made it is the coach's decision where a player may play even if it is not in a position in which the participant trialled.
- I understand that the HDNA dress, tracksuit, sports bag, socks, polo shirt and hat will be required to be purchased for each team/squad member 12 years and over. I understand that the HDNA polo shirt, socks and hat will be required to be purchased for each team/squad member in the 11 year age group.
- I agree to fully support, without interference, the decisions made by the coaching staff of my daughter's team/squad AT ALL TIMES. I understand that failure to adhere to this agreement could result in my daughter being withdrawn from the program.
- I understand that should my daughter be selected for a Junior State Titles team at Phase III selections or later, she will be allocated by the Coach a minimum of 40% court time over the course of the Titles, as per Netball NSW regulations.
- I can confirm that my daughter will not be absent from the program due to a planned holiday for longer than 2 weeks. (Any emergency situations will be taken into account.)
- I have read the HDNA Junior Reps Information Book available on the HDNA website and understand and agree with the obligations noted within.
